



## Important Pre-Visit Information

1. To help make the most of your visit to Drayton Hall, and to better prepare your students for the program(s), we suggest that you log on to our website at [www.draytonhall.org](http://www.draytonhall.org) and click on **Visit** where you will find links to **pre- and post-visit materials and activities**, and a list of the South Carolina Academic Standards that correlate with your program(s).
2. Education Programs are presented outdoors; therefore, the students should dress appropriately for the weather. **Bug spray is strongly advised for spring, summer, and fall programs.**
3. Unfortunately, late arrivals may result in an abbreviated program. We maintain a tight schedule with other groups on the property, and may not be able to extend your departure time.
4. If you are planning to picnic at Drayton Hall, we recommend that you bring blankets for the children to sit on since picnic tables may not be available. **Please make sure that names are on lunches and all lunches are together in boxes or containers at the front of the bus or in the bus cargo area.**
5. Please have your students wear large, easy-to-read student name tags that will allow our staff to call the students by name.
6. Personal items such as backpacks and electronics are not allowed during education programs; such items will have to stay on the bus. Clipboards, paper, and pencils are acceptable.
7. Chaperones are an important component of any school visit. Please make sure that your chaperones understand their responsibilities to keep the students together, to help the students follow rules, and to assist the Drayton Hall educators as needed during the program.
8. We would like to invite you and your students to shop in our Satellite Museum Shop set up especially for you. The Satellite Museum Shop features Drayton Hall souvenir items as well as items related to your specific educational program. All items are priced at \$6.00 and under. Please allow an extra 15-30 minutes (depending upon group size) on your itinerary for shopping time. **The shop must be reserved prior to your day of arrival.**
9. Classroom memberships are available to teachers or may be purchased by any individual classroom parent or chaperone. A \$45 classroom membership entitles the teacher to numerous benefits such as free admission for a full year and a classroom poster. It also provides students in the class (up to 35 students) a five-person pass to visit Drayton Hall with their family, free of charge.
